

Study Questions for the November 22, 2020 Sermon:
“The Glory of God in a Healthy Church”
Ephesians 4:11-16

1. Ephesians 4:11 states that Jesus gave his church apostles, prophets, evangelists, shepherds, and teachers. So we can infer that leadership qualities are a gift from God. How can members of a congregation determine if they have been gifted to serve as leaders?

2. Pastor Paul shared a statistic: 15% to 20% of churches are expected to close due to the pandemic. Are there any initiatives we might take to invite these people to Northwest?
 - a. As individual members?
 - b. As a congregation?

3. Ephesians 4:15 is part of a description of Christian maturity. It emphasizes the importance of our speech as we express the love of Jesus to others. Can you recall any other verses that emphasize the role of our speech in our overall Christian demeanor?

4. Memory Question: What did Pastor Paul say is the spiritual dimension of church business meetings?

5. Describe the two benefits of spiritual maturity described in Ephesians 4:14 & 15.
