



**Study Questions for the October 31, 2021 Sermon:
“The First Home”
Genesis 2:4-17**

1. What are some elements of the Garden of Eden that helped Adam to remember his dependence upon God?
2. How was the creation of Adam different from the creation of the animals?
3. God forbade eating of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. How do religious and secular organizations continue to tempt people by referring to forbidden knowledge?
4. Pastor Paul talked about the joy of work before the fall. If you ever had a job which you thoroughly enjoyed, briefly share your experience with the class.
5. Was it fair of God to warn Adam that “...you shall surely die.”, if Adam did not understand death?
6. Pastor Paul said that we will not struggle, after our resurrection, with temptation to sin. Can you recall any verses that support that teaching?
7. Should people try and locate the Garden of Eden? Defend your answer.
8. Why, according to these verses, did God place Adam in the Garden of Eden?
9. When God commanded Adam not to eat of one tree, He gave Adam an opportunity to disobey Him. What does the opportunity to obey or disobey imply about Adam's nature?
